Greater Raleigh houses some of the finest sports facilities in the nation, and many are planning for or already undergoing upgrades. Below is a short update on our facilties.

• The Cary Tennis Park: One of the largest in the Southeast, is going through a major expansion, which includes the installation of high-quality covered courts and other improvements throughout the

park · Walnut Creek Softball Complex: Is upgrading its facility, with a complete renovation to all nine fields and improved

ADA access to all areas of the venue. • National Training Complex: USA Baseball continues to build its event

schedule, with dozens of popular tournaments returning to Cary. USA Baseball's primary season runs from March to September.

• PNC Arena: Has seating for almost 20,000 and 66 luxury suites, and has hosted NCAA men's and women's basketball tournaments, the Stanley Cup Final, the NHL All-Star Weekend and the NHL Entry Draft.

· WakeMed Soccer Park: Is the home of two professional teams, North Carolina FC (NASL) and North Carolina Courage (NWSL). Operated by the Town of Cary, WakeMed Soccer Park features a 10,000-seat stadium, seven additional fields and an outstanding cross-country course with 5K, 6K and 8K courses.

 Other venues include: Five-County Stadium for baseball in Zebulon; Carter-Finley Stadium for football at N.C. State University; the Raleigh Convention Center, home to the Deep South Classic, City of Oaks volleyball and multiple indoor sports events. It is a multi-purpose state-of-the-art facility with more than 500,000 square feet under cover including a 150,000-square-foot exhibit hall; Triangle Aquatic Center, a popular spot to host regional and national swimming championships, including USA Swimming events and the annual National Black Heritage Championship Swim Meet.

The list continues to grow as the community invests in both upgrades and expansions of existing facilities as well as plans for new venues on the horizon.

"We are fortunate here in Greater Raleiah to have a slew of world-class facilities. Other factors that strengthen our bids include our superb host partners and our abundance of hotel rooms. We're convenient and have a great climate. But most of all, we have tremendous community support and we provide all our visitors with a dynamic experience.
