

OVERVIEW:

The USTA National Campus, located at Lake Nona in Orlando, Fla., opened in January 2017. The groundbreaking facility is designed to enhance the sport at every level and create an unparalleled playing, training, coaching and educational experience for recreational players, competitive players, coaches and spectators. More than 100 international, national and local events and tournaments are scheduled at the campus in 2017.



FACILITY/DESTINATION INFORMATION:

The USTA National Campus boasts a total of 100 lighted tennis courts. Amenities include an expansive retail pro shop, racquet stringing, and a full-service restaurant and cafe. The campus serves as an epicenter for tennis innovation, providing opportunities for the testing and growth of new and emerging technologies and serving as a lab for sports science. PlaySight provides live streaming on 84 courts, while 26 courts are equipped with SmartCourt technology that provides in-depth analytics.

SPECIAL FEATURES:

The USTA National Campus has cemented itself as an event destination, hosting a number of junior, collegiate, and professional events in 2017, and was awarded the NCAA Division I Tennis Championships in 2019 and 2021, as well as the Division III Championships in 2022. The campus sits adjacent to the Orlando International Airport, with a number of dining, lodging and shopping options nearby, and is within about 20 minutes of Orlando's theme parks.
